Brief Report

Food Relief

From late March through July 20, our partners have provided us with funds for 77 food relief outreaches across Guatemala. Each effort has impacted an average of forty families, for about 3,080. With at least four people per family, we estimate you've helped us provide three meals a day for fourteen days around 12,320 people. That translates to 517,440 meals!!!

Country News

Guatemala has yet to begin reopening. The country is on strict curfews from 6pm to 5 am M-F and 2pm Saturday through 5am Monday. No one can move on the weekends. Much of the country is also under a State of Siege, where normal civil liberties are suspended.
